MARINA: FIRST MONTH

Leyland Australia has announced that sales of the new Marina range of cars have exceeded planned production.

Since the release of the car on April 7, 1972, retail sales reported by dealers to the end of April totalled more than 1300, an average of 83 a day for every working day.

May production has been increased to allow dealers to continue selling at a high level.
